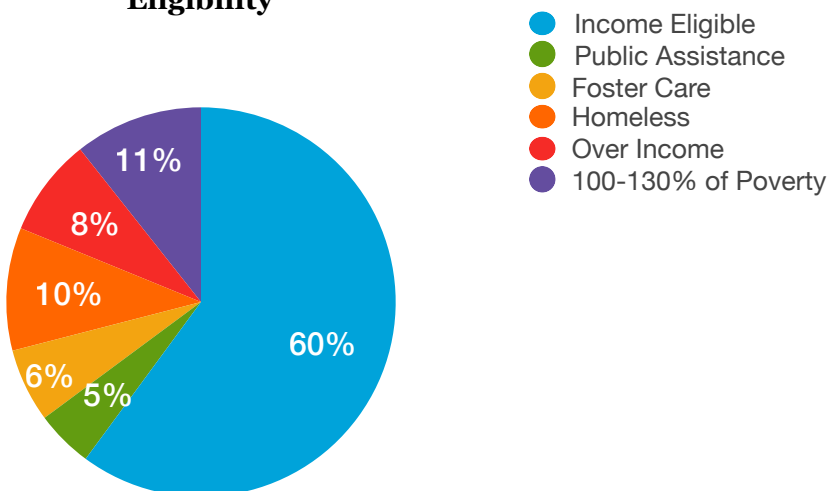
RURAL UTAH CHILD DEVELOPMENT

The RUCD team works well together to provide strong support and leadership, creating a consistent and quality learning environment. Children receive individualized lesson plans with developmentally appropriate learning experiences, and families are involved with their children's education while

they receive assistance with personal goals, parenting information, and leadership through parent committees and Policy Council.

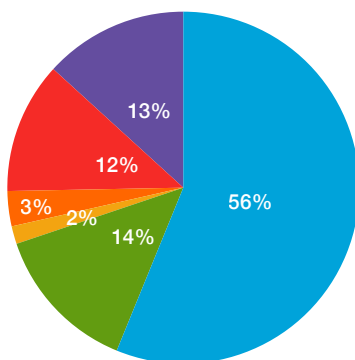

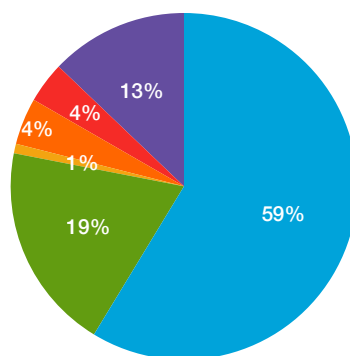
Parent Engagement

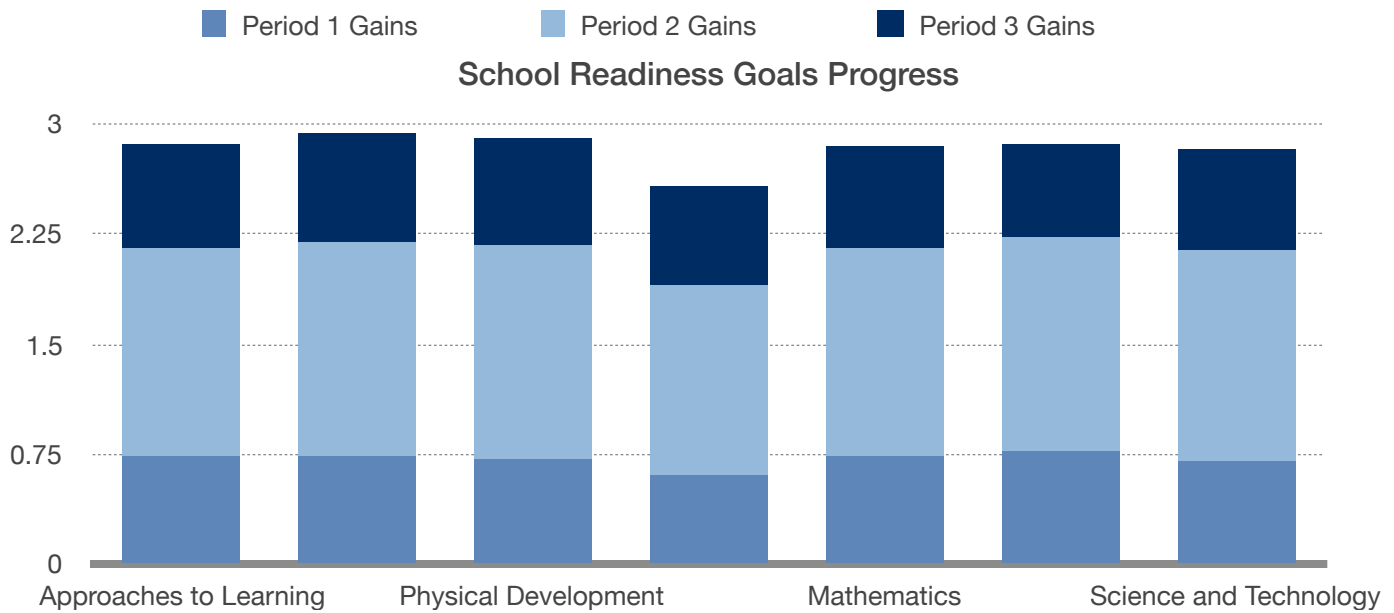
